Georgia Chachami received a Diploma in Biology from the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, and a Ph.D. from the University of Thessaly, Faculty of Medicine (Laboratory of Biochemistry, group of Prof. George Simos). She received her postdoctoral training as an Alexander-von-Humboldt fellow in Heidelberg at the ZMBH Institute for Molecular Biology, Universität Heidelberg, (group of Prof. Frauke Melchior). She was appointed Lecturer of Cellular Biochemistry in 2014 and Assistant Professor in 2020, at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Thessaly, where she started her research group. Her research interests focus on the identification of new control points and novel players in transcriptional regulation under low oxygen concentration (hypoxia). She is currently investigating the involvement of protein SUMOylation in gene expression during the hypoxic response.
